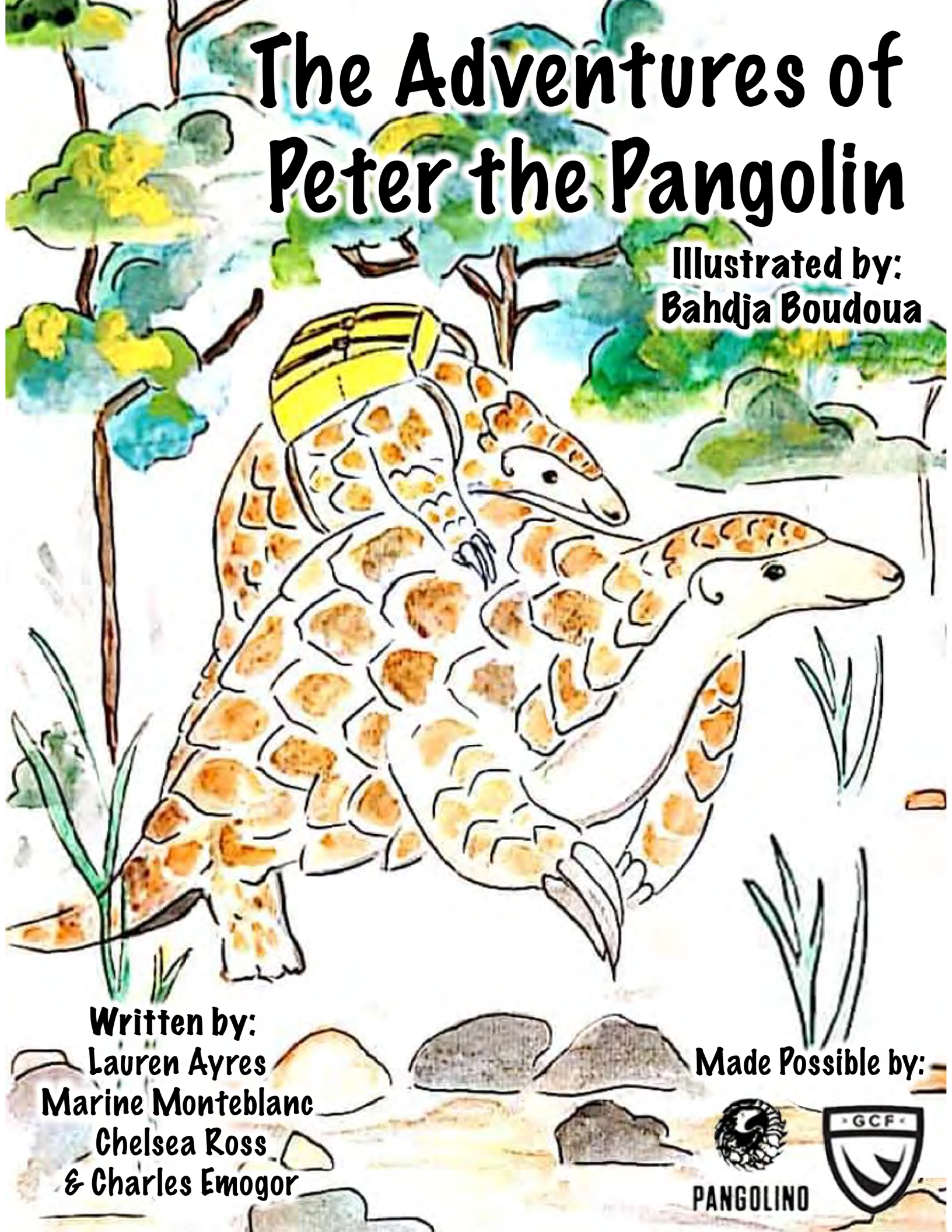

# What is a pangolin??

Pangolins are insect-eating mammals that are covered in tough scales. The scales are made of keratin, which is the same material as your fingernails and hair.

Pangolins have powerful front claws that they use to dig into logs or dirt mounds. They have a long, sticky tongue that they use to eat ants and termites. Some pangolins dig in the ground, while others climb up trees. Pangolins roll into a ball and use their scales like armor to defend themselves.

There are eight different species of pangolins that live in tropical forests and grassland habitats across Asia and Africa. All eight species are in danger of becoming extinct, which means they will no longer exist, like the dinosaurs. Since all eight species of pangolins are threatened with extinction, they are classified as "endangered animals." They need our help to save them!

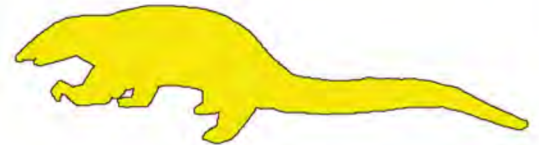

## Temminck's Pangolin



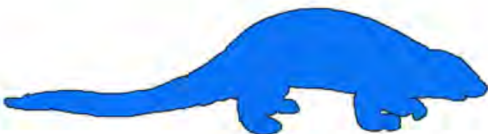

## Black-bellied Pangolin



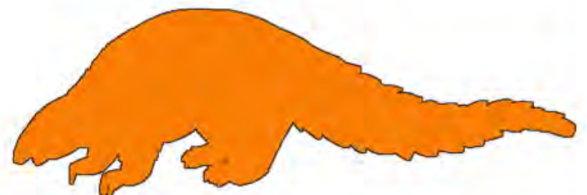
